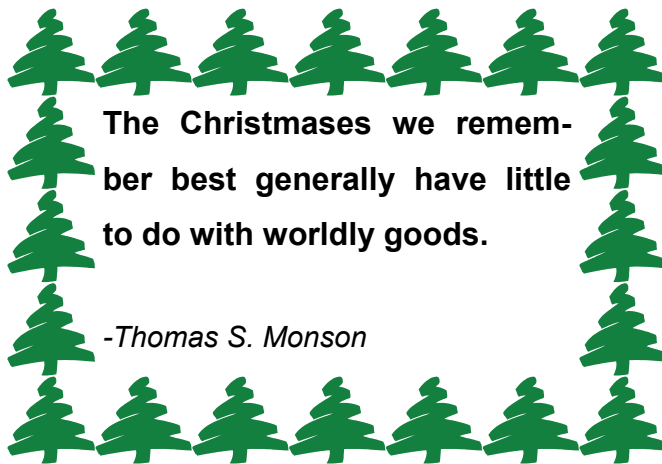


Franklin Pierce Providing Goodwill to Men
